
This letter is to certify that Cameron Bellamy successfully completed a solo unassisted circumnavigation swim of the island of Barbados.

Cameron left from in front of Copacabana Beach Bar, Carlisle Bay at 11:20am on Sunday 11 November 2018 and finished in front of Copacabana Beach Bar, Carlisle Bay at 4:06am on Tuesday 13 November 2018 for a total duration of 40 hours and 46 minutes and a distance of approximately 96.4 kilometres. Cameron swam in a counter clockwise direction around the island of Barbados.

The Barbados Amateur Swimming Association (BASA) acknowledge that the swim was completed in accordance with the swim rules as set out by BASA which follow swim rules as set out by the Marathon Swimmers Federation (MSF). BASA appointed official observers for the swim, the head observer being Alison Pile. The other official observers included: John Mike Peterkin, Zary Evelyn, Samantha Clarke, Jonathan Pile, Jimmy Clarke, John Howard, Chris Sikkens and Amanda Garcia. There were two observers on duty at any given time the entire duration of the swim. At least one observer was in constant view of Cameron through the duration of the swim.
